General Park Reservation Information

The City of Woodway would like to thank you for renting our facility. Below is a list of rules that we have to keep our facility in good condition.

1. Change to Park Reservations: Effective June 1, 2010, all park reservations will be handled by the Parks Department in the Community Services and Development Building, located at 924 Estates Drive. They can be reached at 254-772-4050. The City accepts reservations for the use of the pavilions in Poage Park and Whitehall Park, the gazebo at Poage Park, and the small shelter at the playground area in Whitehall Park. An additional cleaning deposit may be charged and is refundable after favorable inspection of the pavilions to ensure the facilities are left clean and undamaged. ***Please note: park reservations for the weekend must be made by 1 pm on the Friday before.***
2. No reservation shall be valid unless payment in full is received in the Community Services and Development offices prior to 1:00pm on the last regular work day preceding the date of the reservation. **This fee is refundable at the rate of 50% if receipt for event is turned into Community Services at least 48 hours prior to the reservation.** Paid reservation dates may be changed one time without forfeiting any part of the reservation fee if requested in writing at least 48 hours prior to the reservation.
3. The city reserves the right to charge and collect an additional cleaning deposit, as determined by the City Manager, or his designee, that is refundable after favorable inspection of the pavilion to ensure the facilities are left clean and undamaged.
4. Set-up and clean-up must be included in reservation time. (This includes set-up time and removal of additional tables/chairs, decorations, cleaning, etc.)
5. **ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE PROHIBITED.**
6. **IF ANY EQUIPMENT IS TO BE USED THAT WILL REQUIRE ELECTRICITY, PLEASE NOTIFY THE OFFICES BY 5:00PM ON THE TUESDAY PRIOR TO THE EVENT. ALL COSTS WILL BE BORN BY THE RENTERS. THE CITY HAS A TOTAL OF 4 PARKS THAT CAN ONLY SUPPORT MINIMAL ELECTRICAL NEEDS.**
 - **POAGE PARK – HAS TOTAL OF 8 ELECTRICAL OUTLETS; CONNECTED TO ONE 20AMP BREAKER.**
 - **WHITEHALL PARK - HAS TOTAL OF 1 ELECTRICAL OUTLET; CONNECTED TO ONE 20AMP BREAKER.**
 - **WOODWAY PARK I - HAS TOTAL OF 6 ELECTRICAL OUTLETS: CONNECTED TO ONE 20AMP BREAKER**
 - **WOODWAY PARK II- HAS TOTAL OF 6 ELECTRICAL OUTLETS; CONNECTED TO ONE 20AMP BREAKER.**
7. Please check with the City offices on the Noise Ordinance if you plan to use a radio, loud speaker, disc jockey, etc. Any complaints on noise nuisance could result in closure of the event.
8. Please note that the reservation is for the pavilion or gazebo only and not the entire park; therefore others may use the park the day you have scheduled.

Rentals

Effective June 1, 2010, all park reservations will be handled by the Parks Department in the Community Services and Development Building, located at 924 Estates Drive. They can be reached at 254-772-4050.

The City accepts reservations for the use of the pavilions in Poage Park and Whitehall Park, the gazebo at Poage Park, and the small shelter at the playground area in Whitehall Park. An additional cleaning deposit may be charged and is refundable after favorable inspection of the pavilions to ensure the facilities are left clean and undamaged. No reservation shall be valid unless payment in full is received at Community Services & Development offices at 924 Estates Drive.

Please note: park reservations for the weekend must be made by 1 pm on the Friday before.

Park Rules

- Alcohol is Prohibited
- Advertising in City Parks is prohibited.
- Neighborhood park curfew: 11 p.m. - 5 a.m.
- Pets must be on leashes at all times.
- All wildlife in City parks is protected.
- It is unlawful to litter in City parks.
- It is unlawful to cut or destroy vegetation.
- All vehicles must park in designated areas.
- All firearms and airguns are prohibited.
- All vendors must have an approved permit.
- No campfires, dunking booths, or off-road vehicles allowed in parks.
- Golfing or “practice golfing” of golf balls is prohibited.
- Tents must be pre-approved and location coordinated with parks operations staff.
- Glass beverage containers are prohibited.

Poage Park – 100 Poage Drive (*Located at the intersection of Poage Drive and Highway 84*)
Capacity is approximately 100-150 people

- ❖ Pavilion with approximately 10 Picnic tables

- ❖ Walking track (3 laps = 1 mile)
- ❖ Sand volleyball court
- ❖ Playground
- ❖ Restrooms

Whitehall Park – 7600 Fresno Drive (*Located off of Santa Fe Drive*)
Capacity is approximately 100 people

Features:

- ❖ 30 foot Six-sided pavilion
- ❖ 6 picnic tables
- ❖ Walking Track (4/10 mile)
- ❖ Cement volleyball court
- ❖ BBQ grills
- ❖ Playground
- ❖ Restrooms

Woodway Park- Located at the end of Estates Drive (*adjacent to Lake Waco*)
Special Conditions may apply - Please contact (254)772-4050 for rental information.

- ❖ Frisbee golf course
- ❖ Small Pavilion at Park I and Park II
- ❖ Hiking Trails (Newly Reconditioned)
- ❖ Picnic tables located throughout park
