Woodway Family Center Programs

Fall Sports – Flag Football, Soccer & Volleyball

The WFC offers Flag Football for Kindergarten – 6th grade, Soccer for Pre-Kindergarten – 4th grade and Volleyball for 3rd – 6th grade. Registration for Fall sports begins mid-July; practices start in September and games are finished by the end of October. All Football, Soccer and Volleyball leagues are co-ed.

Winter Sports – Basketball

The WFC offers basketball for Kindergarten – 6th grade. Our basketball league is NOT co-ed. Teams are separated according to age & gender. Registration will begin in October. Practices will begin mid-November; games will start after January 1st and end before Spring Break.

Spring Sports – T-ball, Coach Pitch Baseball & Volleyball

The WFC offers T-ball for Pre-Kindergarten – 1st grade, Coach Pitch for Kindergarten – 3rd grade and Volleyball for 3rd – 6th grade. Registration will begin at the beginning of January. Practices will begin in April and games will finish by the end of May. All T-ball, Coach Pitch and Volleyball leagues are co-ed.

Summer Sports – T-Ball & Coach Pitch

The WFC offers T-ball for Pre-Kindergarten – 1st grade and Coach Pitch for Kindergarten – 3rd grade. Registration will begin in April. Practices will start at the beginning of June and games will conclude by the end of July.

Summer Sport Camps – Soccer, Football, Volleyball & Basketball

The WFC offers Soccer, Football, Volleyball and Basketball camps during the month of June. Registration for the camps will begin in April. Contact the WFC for details.
