



Become a better informed citizen – join the CPA

Now Accepting Applications for the Citizens' Police Academy

Have you ever wondered what it would be like to be a Police Officer or Firefighter? Everyone at some point, whether it was when we were children or when watching NCIS, has fantasized about fighting crime and saving the day!

This is where the Woodway Public Safety Citizen's Police Academy comes in. Be a detective and learn how to locate and lift a suspect's fingerprints (then do it!); be a patrol officer and learn how to conduct traffic stops and high risk felony stops; but don't stop there, learn the technique and perform the handcuffing to complete your mission. Lastly, don't forget your bunker gear, because those glowing red lights are not coming from your patrol car. Learn the functions of a Woodway firefighter, ride the fire trucks, wear the bunker gear and

even hit the obstacle course if you choose. The Woodway Public Safety Citizen's Police Academy (CPA) is an extremely low pressure environment that can be as active or idle as you choose. The academy is offered once a week for 8 weeks beginning in February and will immerse participants in the daily activities associated with police and firefighting. Did we mention that this whole program is free and you don't have to be a Woodway resident to apply? What are you waiting for? Seats are filling quickly, and joining is as simple as filing out this pamphlet and turning it in.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What is the Citizens' Police Academy?

A: The Citizens' Police Academy is a FREE program that teaches citizens about the day-to-day operations & challenges the Woodway Public Safety Department faces & exists to help citizens gain a better understanding of police & fire services. Class is held for three hours one night a week for eight (8) weeks & is held at the Woodway Public Safety Department.

Q: What is the purpose of the academy?

A: The purpose of the academy is to enhance positive relations between the Public Safety Department & the community through education. The goal of the academy is to create a growing core of responsible & well-informed citizens to aid in creating a positive public opinion relating to police & fire services. Citizens are given an opportunity to offer comments & ideas regarding solutions to problems & challenges facing Woodway law enforcement.

Q: What is taught in the program?

A: A variety of topics are covered highlighting each public safety section & the history of the Woodway Public Safety Department. Guest speakers are invited to discuss the K-9 Unit, the District Attorney's Office, & the McLennan County Sheriff's Office. In addition to classroom time, participants will have the opportunity to ride with patrol officers & attend a practice session on the training grounds.

Q: How are citizens selected?

A: Citizens are selected based on an application process for limited spaces in the program. To apply, complete & send in the application form located in this brochure. After your application is received, a background check will be completed & you will be notified if you are selected to participate. There is no fee to apply.
