

ORDINANCE 16-14

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODWAY, TEXAS; AMENDING CHAPTER 12, OFFENSES-MISCELLANEOUS, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF WOODWAY, TEXAS, SECTION 12-6 DISCHARGING AIR GUNS; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE, AND FINDING AND DETERMINING THAT THE MEETING AT WHICH THIS ORDINANCE IS ADOPTED WAS NOTICED AND WAS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AS REQUIRED BY LAW.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODWAY, TEXAS:

SECTION I

That Chapter 12, Offenses-Miscellaneous, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Woodway, Texas, Section 12-6 Discharging Air Guns is hereby amended, in its entirety, to read as follows:

Sec. 12-6. - Discharging air guns and other weapons.

It shall be unlawful for any person to shoot or discharge any air gun, air rifle or other weapon into, on or across any other's property, public street, avenue, alley or highway, or in any public place whatsoever. The terms "air gun" and "air rifle" mean any instrument or weapon which is commonly known as an air gun or air rifle, and which propels a bullet or other hard pellet with a carrying force as much as twenty-five (25) yards. Other weapons in this section refer to archery equipment and/or any other type of projectile weapons not considered a firearm under state law.

SECTION II

That if any provision of this ordinance is found by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unconstitutional or unenforceable, or if the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstances is found to be invalid, unenforceable or unconstitutional, such invalidity, unenforceability or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or application of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid, unenforceable or unconstitutional provisions or application.

SECTION III

That all ordinances, codes, regulations, policies and guidelines of and in the City of Woodway, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION IV

That it is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this ordinance is passed is open to the public as required by law and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by law.


