

ORDINANCE NO. 16-17

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODWAY, TEXAS AMENDING CHAPTER 17 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF WOODWAY, TEXAS RELATING TO SUBDIVISIONS TO REPEAL SECTION 17-16 REGARDING PARKLAND DEDICATION REQUIREMENTS, PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE, EFFECTIVE DATE, AND FINDING OF ADOPTION AT AN OPEN MEETING HELD IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 551 OF THE TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODWAY, TEXAS THAT:


SECTION 1. Chapter 17 (Subdivisions) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Woodway, Texas is amended to REPEAL Section 17-16, entitled "Parkland dedication requirements" in its entirety, and Section 17-16 shall be shown as "reserved."

SECTION 2. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this ordinance are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation in this ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall become effective upon passage and in accordance with the applicable laws of the State of Texas and the Charter of the City of Woodway.

SECTION 4. It is found and declared that the City Council meeting at which this Ordinance has been adopted was open to the public and was noticed and held in accordance with Chapter 551 of the government code.
