Friday evening, May 27th we kick off the Roadrunner Festival with the Woodway Wine Tour. Bring a date or make it a friend's night and enjoy wines from around the world. A food pairing by Milo's and music provided by The Union Revival Band and The Bashara/Klaras Jazz Duo will make it a perfect evening. This is an event you won't want to miss. Limited tickets are available for \$40.00 a piece. Tickets are sold in advance, call 254 399-9204.

Saturday begins indoor/outdoor fun, food and live music for the whole family. Our Main Stage boasts acts like Kaylee Rutland and the Chris Low Band. The Hometown Stage showcases the talent of local student performers. Enjoy a Classic Car & Motorcycle Show and take part in the Kids Zone, jam-packed with a zip line, petting zoo and tons of exciting and interactive challenges. There's something for everyone to love, and with a low admission price of \$3 for kids ages four to twelve, adults \$6 at the gate and \$5 in-advance, who could resist checking out all the fun? **July 20th, Lawn Care — Dr. Casey Reynolds**  
Assistant Professor and State Extension Turfgrass Specialist,  
Texas A&M University PhD, Crop Science, North Carolina State  
University (2013)

Dr. Casey Reynolds assists homeowners, landscape professionals, athletic field managers and golf course professionals with maintaining turfgrass in a responsible, efficient manner with regard to water use, pest control, shade and other stresses that may limit turfgrass establishment and maintenance. Extension programming is coordinated with County Agents, Master Gardeners and industry personnel with the goal of reaching as many Texas citizens as possible in an efficient manner.

**August 3rd, Fruits and Nuts — Dr. Larry Stein**  
Professor and Extension Horticulturalist, Department of  
Horticultural Sciences, Texas AgriLife Extension Service,  
Texas A&M University Research and Extension Center

Dr. Stein's work is centered on production horticulture, working with pecans, fruits and vegetables. He has done research on drip irrigation as a means to conserve water, improve fruit quality and increase production. He is a contributing editor to PLANT ANSWERS, a question/answer website forum.

Dr. David Appel joined the faculty of Texas A&M in 1981 to work on the oak mortality problem in Central Texas. His research has largely been centered on the epidemiology, diagnosis and control of oak wilt. He has also worked on *Phymatotrichum* apple root rot, and more recently, Pierce's Disease, which affects wine grapes. Traditional wine grapes cannot be reliably grown in much of the state due to Pierce's Disease.

He has taught undergraduate and graduate courses on introductory plant pathology, diagnosis of plant diseases, forest protection and environmental regulations. Prior to his present assignment as PLPC Program Leader, Dr. Appel served in the Department of Plant Pathology and Microbiology (PLMP) as Associated Department Head for Academic Programs from 1990-2007.

### High Grass, Weeds and Brush

The City is asking for voluntary compliance and help to keep grass, weeds and brush mowed and trimmed according to the City Ordinance (Sec. 11-1 high grass).

All grass, weeds, and brush should be kept to a height



no taller than twelve (12) inches in any location. Keeping grass cut to proper length also helps lessen the possibility of grass fires and aids in controlling mosquitoes, fleas, ticks and other pests. Note: With all the rain the grass is growing fast so you may need to mow your yard more often. Keeping a lawn beautiful all season long does not need to be complicated – keep grass lawn care and maintenance simple.
